## A GUIDE TO COUNCIL MEETINGS

This general overview of a Council meeting and agenda is intended to help you better understand your local government. Council meetings occur on Tuesday nights at 6 p.m. and the Council does not generally meet on a fifth Tuesday of the month.

Much of this information is provided in the City's Governance Manual, a legislative document that serves as a guide for the conduct of legislative/executive operations on behalf of the community.

## Meeting types

Business meeting: Held second and fourth Tuesdays of th Primary purpose is to vote on City business, generally in the motions, resolutions or ordinances. Chaired by Mayor.

Study session: Held first and third Tuesdays of the mon informal than business meeting. Purpose is to study, delib or review emerging issues for potential future action. Final not taken at a study session but there are often procedu Does not include a public comment period. Chaired by Mayor.

Public comment: During business meeting, any member public may address full Council on any public issue, wheth or not it's on agenda. Unless Council determines otherwis public comment period is not for responses from Council administration.

Future Council agendas: Any council member may requ the addition of an item to a future agenda. If there is gene Council support or majority vote of Council to proceed, th item will be added to upcoming meeting agenda. If there not support by majority of Council, then item will be place under Future Council agendas for 10-minute discussion or whether to schedule the item.

Public hearing: A formal opportunity to share your views with the Council on the subject of the hearing. The hearing may be required by Washington state statute or C ordinance.

City Council discussion: Extra time for consideration of some items.

For the good of the order: Time set aside for members to offer comments/observations (without formal motions) about Council's work or for items of general interest to community.

Adjournment: Conclusion of meeting.
